

Castle Pines Library



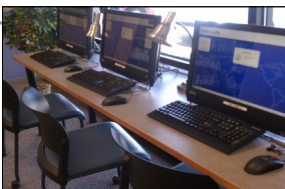
The Need:

Castle Pines community activists came to the library in 2008 after a lost bond issue to ask for special consideration: if they pledged financial support to defray the cost of running a new facility, could we open a library anyhow?

In its first two years of operation, the community helped us raise approximately \$49,000. The library did close the bookmobile and open the library, which has been very well-used. On a square foot basis, the Castle Pines Library may be the busiest library in Colorado.

The Facts:

- In March 2011, 10,272 people walked through the doors!
- At 2300 square feet, Castle Pines is one of the busiest libraries in the district checking out 350,000 materials in 2010!
- Public Library visits, circulation and program attendance all increased during the recession (from 2007 to 2009) by at least 11 percent for libraries serving large communities in Colorado.
